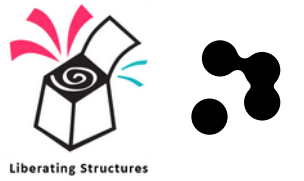

Share the expertise gained from experience

Benefits

For the facilitator

Create favourable conditions for the emergence of new ideas.


For the participant

Discover answers to their concerns. Learn from others.

During this activity, a small group of participants or experts with a common issue helps others understand what happens in the field by sharing their experiences. They sit in a circle, surrounded by the other participants. Initially, those in the inner circle engage in informal discussions while those in the outer circle observe. After sharing their observations, the participants in the outer circle ask questions. Implementing this activity facilitates experience sharing and the adoption of new practices.

Sequence

5 min	Activity presentation	<i>In plenary</i>	The facilitator explains the objective and structure of the activity, introducing the group to the issue that will be addressed.
20 min	Restitution 1	<i>In plenary</i>	Participants or experts with the common issue sit in a circle and share their experiences. The other participants surround them and observe.
5 min	Formulation / Introspection	<i>In groups</i>	Participants in the outer circle step aside to discuss their observations in small groups and formulate questions for those in the inner circle. Meanwhile, those in the inner circle reflect on the previous discussions.
20 min	Restitution 2	<i>In plenary</i>	The inner circle participants answer questions posed by those in the outer circle.
10 min	Debrief	<i>In plenary</i>	The facilitator debriefs the activity with participants, asking them what they have gained for their own activities or projects.
